# Pediatric Dentist/ Children dentist

Pediatric Dentists who treat children younger than 18 years old and patients with special needs. They make children's experience at the dentist to be positive.

#### Children teeth cleaning and fluoride gel application

Fluoride application every 6 months can strengthen enamel and protect teeth against damage from plaque It can help the teeth repair any minor damage from tooth decay.

### Fluoride varnish Application

Fluoride varnish slows down the development of decay . It makes the enamel more resistant to acid attack, and speeds up remineralisation. It is the best solution for kids.

### Children tooth filling

Fillings are most commonly needed due to tooth decay or caries. Leaving it untreated to fall out can cause the decay to spread within the tooth and to other teeth leading to pain for the child.

### Milky tooth root canal treatment

Root canals on baby teeth is to maintain the remaining milky tooth structure. A root canal can prevent infection and ensure the developing teeth stay enough space and healthy.

#### Stainless Steel Crowns for Kids

Stainless Steel crown is an extremely durable restoration for children with extensive decay, following multiple surfaces of caries and root canal tooth.

### Dental sealant (Prevention from cavity/caries)

Sealants protect the deep pit and fissure. Easy to apply. Sealants are durable and can last several years .

#### White crowns for Kids (Zirconia)

Zirconia crowns are aesthetically one of the best dental restorative options available, as they blend in with your child's other teeth. They do not chip, discolor, or breakdown over time.

#### Pull out baby tooth

A baby tooth that is significantly decayed or infected may also require extraction. If a filling or a root canal is not enough to save it, extraction is eliminate the pain and toothache.
